

**AVOYELLES PARISH POLICE JURY**  
**SPECIAL SESSION**  
*Tuesday, October 16, 2018*

The Police Jury of the Parish of Avoyelles, State of Louisiana, met in Special Session at its regular meeting place, the Police Jury Meeting Room of the Parish Courthouse, on Tuesday, October 16, 2018, at 5:00 p.m. (CST).

There were present: Charles Jones, Mark Borrel, Marsha Wiley, Glenn McKinley, Kirby Roy, John Earles Henry Moreau and McKinley Keller

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Kirby Roy.

The invocation was given by President Charles Jones.

The Police Jury of Avoyelles Parish, was duly convened as the governing authority of said Parish by Hon. Charles Jones, President, who welcomed all present and stated the Police Jury was ready for the first item of business.

The President asked if there were any public comments. The comments from the audience is as follows:

On motion by Henry Moreau, seconded by John Earles, the Avoyelles Parish Police Jury does hereby rescind the following motion made on October 9, 2018:

*After publication soliciting bids, one bid was received and opened publically. On motion by Henry Moreau , seconded by Trent Clark, the Avoyelles Parish Police Jury does hereby award to the low bidder, Ruben Dauzat o/b/o Trifolia, L.L.C, in the amount of \$2,125.25, for the purchase of Themus Jeansonne Bridge “as is” condition and deems necessary to abandon said bridge and property and related rights-of ways due to the fact the bridge serves no public purpose. This abandonment includes all right of access, ingress and egress thereto including maintenance and responsibility of said structure. The bid was less than the required bid minimum (\$12,300.00) as advertised. Juror Moreau offered the motion to accept the bid and award it due to the parish inability to maintain the bridge. The estimate to repair is over \$200,000.00 and the bridge provides access for agriculture purposes only. Jurors Moreau felt there was no need to spend a significant amount of money when there was one offer from an individual to purchase. For these justifiable reasons the motion was submitted for a vote and carried.*

On vote, the motion carried.

On motion by Henry Moreau, seconded by John Earles the Avoyelles Parish Police Jury does hereby reject a bid received by Trifolia, L.L.C, in the amount of \$2,125.25, for the purchase of Themus Jeansonne Bridge. On vote, the motion carried.

On motion by Henry Moreau, seconded by Mark Borrel, the Avoyelles Parish Police Jury does hereby approve to re-advertise soliciting bids for the purchase of Themus Jeansonne Bridge. On vote, the motion carried.

*The Avoyelles Parish Police Jury will receive sealed proposals until 4:00 p.m., November 9, 2018 for the purchase of Themus Jeansonne Bridge. Sealed proposals may be delivered to the Avoyelles Parish Police Jury, Office of Secretary/Treasurer, 312 N. Main Street, Marksville, La 71351, to be received no later than the proposal deadline. All proposals must be marked on the outside of the envelope “Sealed Bid”. Proposals received after the deadline will not be considered. Proposals will be opened and read aloud on Tuesday, November 13, 2018 at 5:45 p.m. in the Police Jury Meeting Room. The Avoyelles Parish Police Jury reserves the right to waive any formalities and reject any and all proposals.*

There being no further business, on motion by John Earles, seconded by Marsha Wiley, the meeting adjourned.
